Meeting Minutes December 6th, 2012

The monthly meeting of the LCRCC was held in the Zion Public Library. Dick Hultz called the meeting to order at 7:16 with 22 members present.

Secretary's Report:

The previous month's minutes were accepted as printed in the "Flypaper."

Treasurer's Report:

The treasurer's report was presented by Leonard Martin and accepted as read.

Field Officer's Report:

Jack Bernard reported that he has removed the battery on the tractor, but will reinstall it before the Jan. 1st event. He has also secured the tables and chairs around the field but left out a few (start-up) stands for winter flying. He has also taken 3 of the prep stands in for repairs. He asked the club about the possibility of putting tarps around the perimeter of the parking area to help keep the gravel off of the grass.

Jack requested that snow removal efforts (from the parking area) place snow in the SW corner of the lot. He also thanked Ed Dodich and Herb Ehnert for assisting in the winter preparations.

Safety Report:

Johnnie Russell reported that there have been no problems. And that the whole year in general was very good as far as the safety of our Club.

Events Director:

Bill Rago reported that the "Annual New Year's Day" bash is good to go. Jim Spice and Bill will provide power (generators) and he will have the Chili and coffee ready by 10am. Heaters, etc. are being provided by Dick and others. Chili by Jack Bernard, doughnuts and coffee by Bill Rago.

Old Business:

Dick reported that Bill Rago sent in our damaged TX for repair and that all our trainers are now fixed and ready for the coming season.

The issue of a small mower and extra gas cans was brought up and Jack informed the club that he had just purchased some cans.

Johnnie Russell also told us that he is donating a small mower to Club, along with a propane heater. The issue of "Timely Dues" was brought up, as Leonard reported that last year 6 people had not renewed their memberships by the March meeting deadline. This year the provision "for a new member

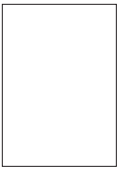
