Meeting minutes June 6, 2013

The Monthly meeting of the LCRC was held in the Zion Public Library. Dick Hultz called the meeting to order at 7:17 with 16 members present and 4 guests.

Secretary report:

Previous months minutes were accepted as printed in the "Flypaper."

Treasurers Report:

The treasurer's report was presented by Dick (in Leonard's absence), and accepted as read.

Field officer report:

Jack, reported that he was out to the field and is was in great shape. He also expressed a concern though, about grass staining due to fuel spills and Jet start-ups. Dick said we were going to address this issue later in the meeting.

Safety Report:

Chuck has had no reported incidents, and the previous issue of "Low pass fly-bys" has been termed a non-issue. (As the AMA has no specific guide lines, other than the Jet rules for speed restrictions)

Events Director:

Bill Rago informed the group that everything is set up for the monthly Fun fly. Jay Imroth will be doing the cooking. He also wanted to thank Jack Bernard for providing the drinks last month. He also went on to say it was a great event and all the food was consumed. Bill requested someone take pictures of this month's event (as he will not be able to attend) and forward them to him for publication in the "Flypaper". He also requested that when anyone sends pictures or information to him, to please include your name. So that he knows who to credit for them. (Not just an email addy)

Old Business:

Dick brought in the Club's "40th Anniversary" sign that he had made up. This will be mounted on the frequency board. He also reminded everyone that this was the last chance to order Club jackets and shirts. The order will be going in on Monday, June 10th. No more orders will be taken. As was printed in the "Flypaper".

New Business:

This coming Sunday (June 9th) is Bipe day, Bring your biplane!! Food will be served @ noon. As previously mentioned, Jay Imroth will be cooking.

Last month the subject of the rough surface of the entrance road was discussed. Dick said he spoke with the Forrest preserve and they said because of all the local flooding, things were a bit behind. Somehow we got placed on the "A" list, as our road has been graded. And, aside for some minor rough patches, is in excellent shape!

As was brought up last meeting, (and a reprint of minutes from the "Flypaper") the issue of grass destruction at the field was, again brought up.

Dick reiterated "Fuel spills of *ANY Kind* will not be tolerated. This is destroying our grass! "Also, Jet Turbine startups have to be protected. We discussed this last year and at previous meetings this year but, there still seems to be a problem. Jet guys are responsible for their own (hot exhaust) protective devices.

The Fuel spills are the responsibility of everyone as both gasoline and nitro (along with the jet fuel) will all kill the grass.

Please folks, carry a catch can or tray, or something to prevent the overflow from your fuel tank from going on the ground. Dump any excess either on the gravel parking area or around the fence posts (helps keep the weeds down?)

Dick said he will be looking for violators, and asks that if anyone sees someone not adhering to these requests, please speak to them immediately, as he will be doing the same...

Remember this is **OUR** Field and we need to take care of it!!!

Jim Spice reported that he had received a phone call from Johnnie Russell. He wanted Jim to say "Hi" to everyone from "Sunny Arizona". Gary Allen brought to our attention that we have not confirmed a meeting room date with the Library for next month (July). Due to the fact that the first Thursday is on July 4th our meeting date has

been moved up to July 11th. He will contact the Library on Monday and confirm that we can have the room for that night. A special email will be sent out by Leonard if there is any change to this schedule.

Note; Because of the altered meeting date, our monthly fun fly will be held the following Sunday (July, 14th).

Gary also reported of a meeting he had with Jim Stanzak of the Waukegan Airport regarding this year's air show. Jim is inquiring if the Club would want to participate with a static and flying demonstration/show. More details to come at a later date but it seems like we would like to do this.

Jim Spice brought up an issue about the Club's VCR collection. Years ago we tried to copy some of these to DVD, with little success. The issue now is what to do with them. They had been stored in the Tractor shed and many are destroyed.

After some discussion with the Members, it was decided, that Jim will bring cases of the VCR's to various club events. And anyone wishing to have them may do so at their choosing until they are gone. Jim Dubek reported on a friend's family that has a large bunch of R/C gear for sale. He asked if it would be ok for them to bring the items out to the Club Picnic for sale. The Club decided that would ok as long as the display did not interfere with the Picnic raffle.

We had two new Members at the meeting, Doug and Samood. Both are new to the hobby and are asking for "Buddy Box" training to get them flying. Welcome aboard guys!!!

Also present was a former member, Dave Tillis. He and his family are in town visiting and are going to try and make it out to the monthly fun fly this coming Sunday. Good to see old friends back!

Show and Tell:


