Meeting Minutes March 7, 2013

The Monthly meeting of the LCRCC was held in the Zion Public Library. Dick Hultz called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m. with 23 members present and 1 guest.

Secretary's Report:

The previous months minutes were accepted as printed in the "Flypaper."

Treasure's Report:

The treasurer's report was presented by Leonard Martin, and accepted as read.

Field Officer's Report:

Jack reported that the snow plowing has NOT been done entering our Field lot. The main inroad was done (by the FP) but that piled up additional snow at the entrance and now it is really high preventing anyone from entering. No contact has been able to be made with Jim Bucannon to find out what the issue is. Recommendations were made to Dick, that he contact the Forrest Preserve to plow our lot.

Safety Report:

Johnnie Russell has moved to Arizona so there is no safety director at present, and therefore no report. (Also, with the weather and field conditions, there is no flying...)

Events' Director Report:

Bill Rago informed the club of the year's schedule of events. This was set in a BOD meeting held before the "official" monthly meeting ...He asked for, and received, volunteers for cooks at each of the events. Dick commented that this had to be the first year he knew of where this has happened!!

Old Business:

Dick reminded everyone that this month's meeting was the deadline to pay dues and avoid a late payment penalty. As previously discussed, there will be no "Grace" period. Anyone wanting to pay dues from here forward will also have to pay the (\$20.00) new member fee.

The Activity of Indoor flying was brought up. Discussion was had about the Club's involvement with the Kenneth Murphy Elementary school events being held on the 1st and 3rd Sundays. Dave Taylor is in charge of the organization of the fly-ins but the Club will be responsible for carrying the insurance.

On a motion/second/voice vote it was decided to purchase the insurance from AMA to cover these events.

As most are already aware - Johnnie Russell has left the club and moved to "Sunny" Arizona.

Dick recalled all of the help and dedication he had given the Club over his many years as a member. But now that he has gone, there are some positions in the Club's BOD that need to be filled. Dick announced that he has appointed Chuck Smith as our new Club Safety Director and V. Pres. Chuck has accepted these positions...

Also while still on the subject of Johnnie...Jim Spice reported that prior to John's move, He donated MANY airplane kits and prizes to be used at this year's Picnic.

Jim also volunteered to take over for John in the purchase of additional prizes from Greenfield for the picnic and raffle.

There will be a lot to give away this year for sure!!!

Dick reported on an Email he received from a scout leader from Mundelein (Doug Coup) asking if it would be possible to join our Club and get a "special use" permit from the LCFP that would allow all the scouts to be able to fly at the field and train without getting individual permits. They requested a training day on the 20th of April.

After some discussion, it was determined that they (the Scouts) would need to contact the FP as far as obtaining that permit (if possible). But we could provide the training on the 20th... as we have done for Scout groups previously.

Steve Yeaton informed/reminded the group that this year marks the 40th anniversary of the Lake County Radio Control Club!!!

To help celebrate this it was recommended that we make a \$100.00 donation (Buy a brick) to the Outreach scholarship fund of the AMA.

Motion/second/voice vote confirmed this.

There was also much discussion about trying to find information and history of our Clubs past events and people. Anyone having access to this information is asked to come forward with this and help us put an album together.

Show and Tell:

Steve Yeaton brought a "Vectored thrust" EDF jet foamie that he has ready to fly this year. And also showed us a Radio Transmitter (2.4) that he constructed... from "Micro Star" equipment.

Jim Spice brought a Turbine powered CH-53a helicopter that he has been working on and will be flying this year. He also related to the group his history as a pilot on this model in the Marines and that this was the reason for choosing the model to re-produce in scale.

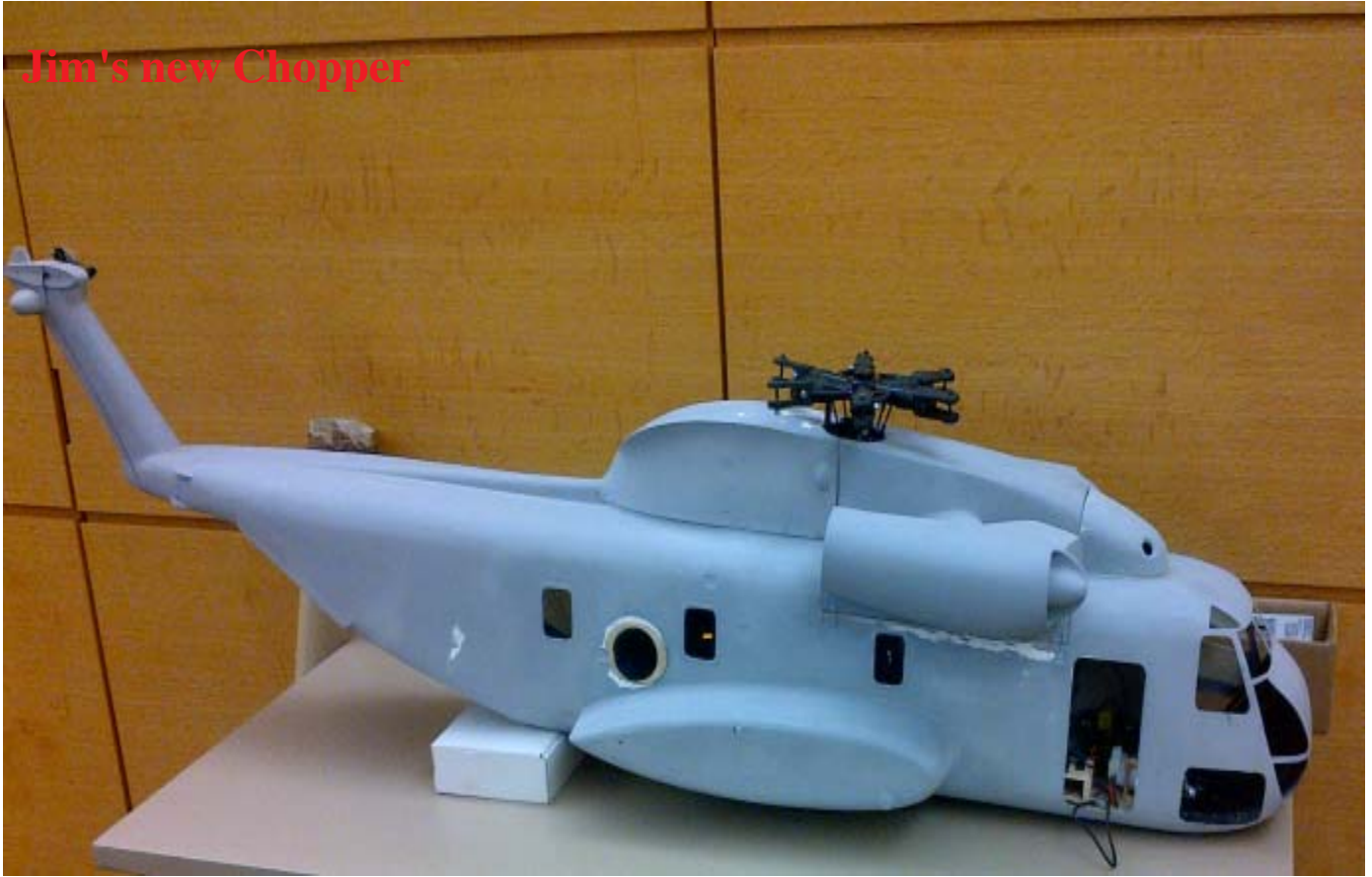
On a motion, second, and voice vote, the meeting was adjourned at 8:18 p.m.

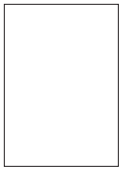
