Meeting Minutes November 1 st, 2012

The Monthly meeting of the LCRCC was held in the Zion Public Library.
Dick Hultz called the meeting to order at 7:20 with 15 members present.

Secretary report:

The previous months minutes were accepted as printed in the "Flypaper"

Treasurers Report:

The treasurer's report was presented by Leonard Martin, and accepted as read.

Field officer report:

Dick reported (for Jack Bernard) that the field has been mowed for the last time this season. And as previously mentioned, Porta-potty service is ended.

Safety Report:

Johnnie Russell reported that there have been no problems.

Events Director:

Bill Rago thanked Jack Bernard for all his work on both the field conditions and helping out with the cooking & refreshments for our season ender event.

He also commented that "Dusty Bird" day should actually been called "Helicopter day" as it seemed everyone decided to "dust off" their helis...But all in all it was a great day with an outstanding turnout.

Bill also informed us that he will be bringing the Coffee and Doughnuts for our annual New Year's Day Bash.

Old Business:

Dick commented on the items that were given to our Club members from the Joe Padraza's estate. Herb Ehnert disclosed that money was collected and given to the family, (Even though they didn't want any money for his stuff), by those taking items.

Next month's Meeting will be held in a different room but still at the Zion Library.

If you get there and can't find the room simply ask at the desk for directions.

As mentioned earlier, the Porta-potty service is cancelled until March 15th 2013.

The club trainer has been repaired by Jack Bernard and Bill Rago got the Transmitter repaired by horizon. Dick repaired the other plane. So, all of the Club's aircraft are back in shape to begin next season.

Dick opened the floor for nominations of club officers. Gary Allen made a motion (and was seconded) that all current officers retain their respective posts.

On a voice vote the nominations were accepted.

Nominations will again be open for next month's meeting.

Indoor flying is now open at the Highland Park Dome. Saturday nights from 10-12pm. There is a 10\$ fee and they may open it up for 1 hour more with an additional 5\$ charge. (10pm-1Am for 15\$) This has not been agreed to by the operators of the Dome, but is under discussion.

Waukegan Indoor flying may start, but they need a minimum of 10 Pilots a night.

On the same subject...Joe's Family is having an open house for anyone wanting his R/C equipment. Sunday 6-9pm everyone should have already gotten an email on this.

There was a discrepancy last month about our meeting room at the Library. This has been resolved and Gary Allen has us booked through Oct of next year. (There may be a change in the room on a few months but we will still have a space to meet in.)

New Business:

Steve Yeaton has been in the hospital with a case of "Shingles". He is out and recovering at home if anyone would like to call on him or send a card.

There is a problem with our meeting schedule for next July...The first Thursday is the 4th. After some discussion a motion was made (and second added) to move our meeting to the following Thursday, July 11th. Voice vote passed. Dick reported on an incident at the field where a father and his sons came out to fly model rockets. They (allegedly) were told by the Forrest preserve that this was OK to do. NO AMA card or Permit was offered. But Dick is concerned that this could present an issue in the future.

Next Month we will be starting Nominations for Officers (Election).

Dick purchased 2 new Wind Socks for the field to replace the tattered ones we had out there.

There was an issue last week with the Scout demos. Someone had changed the settings on the club radios and the battery packs in the TX were dead. Also during the event the wind blew over one of the planes causing tail damage. Dick is looking for a volunteer to repair the plane and take over duties of maintaining the trainer and radios. Bill Rago volunteered to look into the Radio issue.

Dick reported on a Battery shop in Gurnee. "Battery Giant" He was in there and the guy running the store was interested in what the R/C guys needed in terms of batteries. No mention of any kind of club Discount.

The Porta-Potty will only be serviced until the end of Nov.

Dick asked that we inform the people that service it to leave the unit in place for the winter.

Jim Spice reported on the visit he hosted to Chuck Greenhill's hanger and the Russell Military Museum. This was originally a "Skynights" deal but because of fearing a low turnout it was offered to our group although very "last minute".

He will arrange an additional tour in the future for those who could not make this last one.

Show and Tell:

Jim Spice brought in a copy of the Latest issue of "Electric Flight" magazine. His Huey is on the cover and another picture of it and short description in the IRCHA coverage.

New Members:

There were no new members.

On a motion, second, and voice vote, the meeting was adjourned at 7:36pm.




